

Blended Learning Expectations
Spring 2021

Rationale:

In the event of the Academy facing a partial or full closure, we aim as staff to ensure that students have continuity of education. We will provide online live lessons and blended learning resources in all subjects and staff will be supporting you remotely.

Taking care of everyone's own physical and mental health is crucial at this time: this goes for children, parents and teachers. Keeping minds active and happy, ready to return to school when the time comes is the most important factor.

Protocols:

All Blended Learning activities will be hosted via Google Classroom. The google classroom will be the host for online activities (such as recorded PowerPoints, worksheets, links to other providers (such as OAKS National Academy, GCSEPod etc) and will also host Live lessons via Google Meet. A google classroom will be established for each year group as a central repository for announcements, timetables, meeting links etc. These will be set up and monitored by IMI for KS3, SBA for KS4 and NAT for WOA6.

Students in all year groups will receive 25 hours of curriculum time per week delivered either through Live Lessons, or through Blended Learning activities. The content of the online curriculum should be in line with the agreed long-term plans and schemes of work for KS3 and KS4, with adaptations made for students in WOA6, Team Ambition or Team Succeed who will also access therapeutic interventions and an enhanced SEAL/SULP programme to support their individual needs.

In addition to the curriculum each year group will also receive a daily assembly continuing our Smart Start programme focussing on Literacy, Numeracy, CEIAG, Safeguarding and Wellbeing. There are also google classrooms for all students which focus on wellbeing, WOA Workouts for Health and Fitness, Careers and mentoring. Our KS3 and KS4 Catch-up programmes such as reading dogs, Shine, Literacy, numeracy, Albion Foundation and City Year, will also continue to be delivered online through live lessons.

Live lesson Protocols

- Live lesson links will be shared daily via the whole year group google classroom. IMI will post links for KS3 and SBA will post links for KS4. NAT will post links for WOA6
- Weekly Live lessons will be timetabled for each year group following the following the published timetable (examples in appendix) following the minimum expectations:
 - Year 7 and Year 8: Daily Assembly, 2 English, 2 Maths, 2 Science, 1 History, 1 Geography, 1 Religious Studies (RS), 1 Performing Arts (PA), 1 Art, Design & Technology (ADT), 1 MFL and 1 RSHE lesson.

- Year 9: Daily Assembly, 2 English, 2 Maths, 2 Science, 1 History, 1 Geography,
 1RS, CRE8, 1 MFL and 1 RSHE lesson.
- o Year 10: Daily Assembly, 3 English, 3 Maths, 3 Science, 1 of each option subjects and 1 RSHE lesson.
- Year 11: Daily Assembly, 5 English, 5 Maths, 5 Science, and 1 of each option subject.
- WOA6: Daily Assembly, 2 English, 2 Maths, 2 vocational, works skills and ASDAN.
- Live lessons are divided into Bands (Believe, Achieve and Succeed), mirroring the face-to-face curriculum, to allow better differentiation and to accommodate the number limits placed on a google meeting (100 participants).
- Live lessons will be allocated to a member of teaching staff to plan and deliver the lesson, nominated by the head of faculty, and a second member of staff to act as the moderator. The moderation role also allows teachers to share best practice and is a great opportunity for subject specific CPD in how concepts are taught.
- The moderator will be responsible for completing the attendance register, answering student queries via the chat, dealing with any inappropriate behaviours and ensuring staff and students are following the principles of keeping children safe. The HOF will allocate moderators from within their team, or liaise with SLT if support is needed.
- Before each live lesson a holding slide must be displayed that incorporates the rules and expectations for the live lesson. This is included in the appendix.
- A suggested structure for a live lesson has been shared with staff. See Appendix.

Blended Learning Protocols

- A google classroom will be set up for each of a teacher's timetabled classes. Heads of Faculty will be added in as teachers to offer support.
 - o Where a class is shared only one google classroom will be set up with all staff added in. Class teachers of shared classes will come to an agreement on who is setting work and when.
- Class teachers should set 1 online home learning task per normal timetabled lesson, unless superseded by a Live Lesson.
 - O A task may be a PowerPoint to read and respond to, a link to the OAKS National Academy, a series of videos to watch, an extended piece of writing, or an assessment of learning this week. These are just examples and there may be other activities the teacher wishes to set.
- Home Learning tasks should take no longer than 45 minutes to complete. Variety is key and bite-sized chunks of work are more likely to be completed and could be part of a bigger project.
- Tasks should be accessible to all members of the class, and students should be able
 to complete them independently without parents. Parents may be working from
 home or caring for siblings.

The Academy will monitor work completed daily and contact parents on a regular basis. Students will submit work from Live Lessons and Blended learning through Google Classroom). This work will be assessed and students will receive appropriate feedback. Feedback will take different forms. For example:

- individual live feedback,
- whole-class feedback
- quizzes marked automatically via digital platform
- individual comments
- suggestions for improving work submitted.
- Q&A during Live Lessons

Most assessments will continue as planned but be adapted to work online, but some may be rescheduled until students return to school.

Students should communicate with their teachers via Google Classrooms during the lesson.

Additional support for students with particular needs

We recognise that some students, for example some students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) may not be able to access remote education without support from adults at home.

We acknowledge the difficulties this may place on families, and we will work with parents and carers to support those students in the following ways:

- Students needing additional support from adults will be set work that is accessible and has been adapted for their level of need.
- The Academy SEND team will be available to offer additional support should this be required and that will also be contacting students/parents.
- Where appropriate, LSAs will attend Live lessons to support students.

Our SEND provision remains open for students with an EHCP

Tracking of Attendance and Engagement

Student attendance is registered at each live lesson by the moderator.

Students engagement is monitored by individual class teachers through the submission of work following live lessons and blended learning. We will use class charts to record an engagement grade weekly (by Monday 12 noon) for each class. There will be four categories of engagement awarded by individual class teachers using a 'best fit' principle:

Outstanding engagement

(5 points)

- Attend in all live lessons for the subject
- Fully engaged in the live lesson Stars of the lesson
- Completed all blended learning activities for the subject
- All work submitted is beyond classroom teachers' expectations

This data will be used by the engagement team to follow up issues, offer support and access and improve engagement and progress rates.

Parents can support their child by:

- Establishing a school-like routine, that reflects their timetabled lesson hours. A live lesson timetable is emailed to parents each week, posted in year group google classrooms and shared via social media.
- Asking their children to talk them through the subjects and the work they are been set and check that work is being done to the best of your child's ability.
- Contacting your child's Form Tutor immediately if your child is unwell and unable to engage with the lesson and work being set.
- Contacting the school immediately if there are any concerns regarding the work set.
- And ensuring high behaviour expectations when engaging with remote learning.

Rewarding Home Learning

Students will not be awarded a 'minimum expectation' point for attending a live lesson as they would in an in-school lesson. Rather, the engagement gradings above will have achievement points attached to them.

A weekly 'Home Learning Awards' system has been set up to identify learners of the week in each subject area, and Star learners for each Key Stage. This is shared via Google Classroom each week.

Safeguarding and Pastoral support

The moderator in each lesson will act as a safeguard for both staff and students in live lessons.

Pastoral Managers will support SBA in making engagement phone calls on a daily basis for non-attenders.

Pastoral team and form tutors will make weekly safe and well phone calls.

Quality Assurance

Expectations for live lessons and blended learning have been shared with staff via CPD sessions.

A QA system has been developed which is integrated with the academy QA protocols and HOFS and members of SLT will Quality Assure live lessons, blended learning and garner student and parent feedback on remote learning.

The planned CPD programme has been adapted to allow extra support and sharing of best practice for Live and blended learning.

The T&L team will also set up 'Live Lesson Clinics' each week to support colleagues with planning and delivering live lessons.

The moderation role is also a great opportunity for sharing practice and access to subject specific CPD.

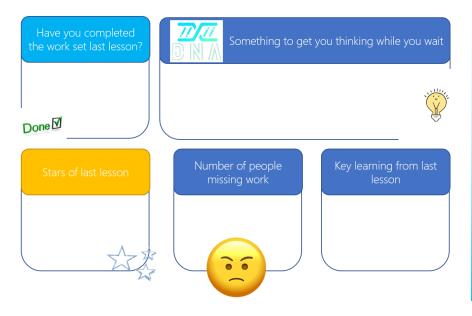
