Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: School Opening – Friday 26th June

Following our previous communication regarding the temporary school closure, I am pleased to confirm that the academy will be **open to all students on the morning of Friday 26th June**. The current forecast indicates the end of the Red Weather Warning, allowing us to safely reopen to all students. We will close early to avoid the peak in temperature and sunlight.

We expect all students to attend for the normal start time of **8:45am**. They can wear WOA PE Kit. We are intending to feed every single child who attends school tomorrow, at lunch, free of charge. They will be dismissed following this at 1pm.

Since the earlier closure, the site team and senior staff have **reviewed and updated the school's risk assessment** in light of the recent extreme weather. A number of precautionary measures have been implemented to ensure a safe and comfortable environment for all:

- Classrooms have been prepared to **maximise cooling and air circulation**, including the use of ventilation, shading and available cooling systems.
- Staff will continue to monitor conditions throughout the morning to ensure that **learning spaces remain safe and well-ventilated**

In addition, **adaptations have been made to the curriculum** for the day to minimise the risk of overheating. This includes:

- Adjustments to **PE activities**, avoiding strenuous exercise.
- Changes within **Food Technology** to limit the use of heat-generating equipment where possible.
- Adaptations to **Performing Arts lessons** to reduce physical exertion and exposure to warmer spaces.

As part of the arrangements for the day:

- All students who attend will be provided with a **free lunch in the canteen from 12:25pm**.
- Students will be **dismissed from site once they have got their lunch at the site will be shut by 1:00pm**.

Reminder: School will be closed, as planned, on Monday 29th June for a Staff Training Day.

We look forward to welcoming students back and thank you for your continued support.
